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HUMAN RIGHTS COMPETITION

Project organised by

“Nicolae Bălcescu” National College, Brăila, România



Scope: Developing Human Rights understanding in our school and within a wider framework – local, national, international.

Objectives:

1. planning activities concerning Human Rights education within our institution;
2. sharing information about our project/competition activities to schools in our community, country and at international level;
3. implementing project activities in our school and in participating schools;
4. evaluating project impact on students and teachers involved in the project and competition.



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Participation: Our institution invites students to participate individually in the following sections:

1. primary (grades 1-4)
2. lower secondary (grades 5-8)
3. upper secondary (grades 9-12).

Organisation of the competition:

1. the competition is organized online, i.e. the entries will be sent by email.
2. for the **PRIMARY section**, the students will participate with ONE of the following : an A4 **poster, drawing, painting** on the topic “**Children’s Rights in my town/city/country**”. Each entry will be scanned or photographed and sent as email attachment, along with the **entry** form.
3. for the **LOWER SECONDARY section**, the students will send a word document with their individual **answers to a set of 10 questions** based on the Charter of Fundamental Rights. The questions will be posted on our school website www.cnnb.ro on the 5th of December; for our international partners, the questions will be sent in English on the email address of the contact person within that school on the same day. Each PDF document with students’ answers will be scanned or photographed and sent as email attachment, mentioning on it the name of the student, grade, school, country, along with the **entry** form. Answers can be sent into the following languages: English, French, German, Spanish.
4. for **UPPER SECONDARY section**, students will write **a composition/essay** of 900-1300 words in which they will discuss, from a personal perspective, one of the following:
 - a. The history of Human Rights
 - b. the Universal Declaration of Human Rights
 - c. Women’s rights
 - d. Human Rights in my Country.Each PDF document with students’ essays (Times new roman font size 12; 1,5 line spacing) will be scanned or photographed and sent as email attachment, mentioning on it the name of the student, grade, school, country, along with the **entry** form. Essays can be written into the following languages: English, French, German, Spanish.

Evaluation Criteria

The papers will be graded according to: following the given theme, respecting format, originality, creativity. The panel of judges consists in team members of the project ”A school for Future Citizens” and representatives of the partner institution The County School Inspectorate.



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The entries in all sections will be sent by **December 10th**, along with the entry form, to **ONE** OF the following email addresses:
