Our high school has around 200 students, which are divided into 8 class, two in each grade. The headmistress is professor Nevenka Lončar, and the school counsellor is professor Jasna Horvat Vlahović. There are currently 23 teachers working in our school.

The school works in two shifts which alternate every two weeks. During the morning shift classes start at 7:10, and end at 14:00 o' clock. In the afternoon shift, classes start at 11:30 and end at 18:00. This comes to a total of 8 school hours every workday. The students study between 15 and 18 subjects. We have Croatian and Maths four times a week and German and/or English two or three times a week. Twice a week we have Biology, Chemistry, History, Geography, PE, Latin, Physics, Computer Science, Philosophy and Sociology. Once a week we have History of Musical Arts, History of Fine Arts, Psychology, Religion or Ethics, Logic and Politics and Economics.

Our school offers a wide array of extracurricular activities for students to choose from and participate in: an all-girls choir, a drama group and various sports activities, to name a few. The eight classes are obliged to choose a president and vice president each year, and these sixteen students make the student's council.

The school offers a truly extensive education programme, and with the many extracurricular activities, every student is guaranteed to find their place here. We may be a small school, but we are all the more closer because of that. We are like a family, and our high school is what ties us together
